- CDM has 35 employees. The North Campus is a happening spot Monday through Friday.
- 90% of our teachers have either a Bachelors or Associates Degree in Early Childhood Education. The other 10% are working with this goal in mind.
- CDM uses the "Creative Curriculum" and teachers use "My Teaching Strategies" to create lesson plans to meet age-appropriate objectives.
- Teachers also use the "Creative Curriculum" assessment GOLD to measure students' progress.
