Frank Moorhead Inducted into the South Carolina Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame

Congratulations to First Church member, Frank Moorhead, who was inducted into the SC High School Basketball Hall of Fame on March 17, 2023. Frank began his basketball career at North Myrtle Beach High School managing both the boys' and girls' junior varsity teams for twenty years, one year coaching boys' basketball at Carolina Forest High School, and nine years as an assistant coach for Coastal Carolina women's team.

Coach Moorhead led his teams to win numerous awards including regional and state finals titles. The NMB High School boys' basketball team won the NMB Optimists Holiday Classic, as well as the Region Championship in 2014. Coach Moorhead's career record of 435-112 averaged 20+ wins per year for 20 years and never lost a season.
