



Missions Committee Report Year-to-date, April 2024

You make a difference in the lives of others, locally, regionally, nationally, and globally. Through your Faith Promise giving, we are able to assist and support the following organizations in helping others.

MISSION SPOTLIGHT: Zoe Empowers, Africa and India (\$9,000). We sponsor the Upendo "Love" Lanyira Group in Kenya, a aroup of 25 households with 100 children. The Zoe Empowers program enables youth-led families of orphaned and vulnerable children to move beyond the need for charity through: Connections with their peers, community leaders, and government officials; Child Rights education so the children can protect one another; Food Security providing resources and knowledge on agricultural practices; Income Generation training group members in skills and business knowledge to succeed; Health and Disease Prevention teaching basic hygiene practices, nutrition, and health treatments; Housing working with the children to improve their living conditions; Education providing assistance for children to attend community schools; and Spiritual Strengthening to help children learn God's love. Zoe Empowers is an amazing organization for which we can be thankful.

Africa University (\$6,000) providing a scholarship for Teresia Michira, a 20-year-old Kenyan first year student in the B.A. (Honors) Social Work program.

Project Agape, Vayk, Armenia (\$8,000) helping Christians in Armenia learn skills to support themselves and their families in this war-torn country.

Cass Community Social Services, Detroit, MI (\$8,500); as Rev. Fowler informed us during Mission Impact Sunday, CCSS continues to meet the needs of the most vulnerable in Detroit.

Agape Love Box Ministry, Horry County (\$2,000), a local faith-based outreach group providing gift boxes for those in spiritual need that Jesus is with them. FUMC has Agape Love Boxes in the church office to give to individuals needing spiritual uplifting.

Epworth Children's Home Columbia, SC (\$3,500) supporting this Methodist program to help children, youth, and families across South Carolina including Foster Care Training.

Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Horry County (\$2,500) supporting Suzanne Renfrow's outreach program providing Christian help to area coaches wives.

Gideons International, Grand Strand (\$2,500) bringing the word of God to locals and visitors to the Grand Strand area.

Habitat for Humanity of Horry County (\$5,000) supporting the building of another Faith Build home in Horry County.

Helping Hand of Myrtle Beach (\$6,500) providing assistance in short-term crisis intervention.

Kids International Ministries (\$2,000) supporting the missionary work of Amy Allen with children in the Philippines.
