

Missions Committee Funds Distribution Report To-Date July 11, 2023

With your support, First United Methodist Church is fulfilling Christ Jesus' call to help those less fortunate. Below are the distributions of funds to-date, accomplished from funds carried over from 2022 combined with the 2023 Faith Promise receipts:

Africa University \$6,000 – 1st year tuition for Gabriela Tinga (Paid in full for 2023).

Agape Love Box Ministry \$1,000 – Gift boxes reminding those in spiritual need that Jesus sees them, knows them, is always with them, and most important, loves them.

Cass Community Social Services \$6,375 – Support United Methodists in Detroit, MI providing for homeless men, women, and children.

Epworth Children's Home \$2,625 – Serving children, youth, and families in SC.

Gideons International \$3,750 – Making the word of God available to everyone.

Habitat for Humanity \$22,625 – Providing individuals a decent place to live (\$19,735 from Missions Memorial fund towards Faith Build Home – FUMC is helping to sponsor).

Zoe Empowers \$6,750 – Equipping orphaned children with skills for long-term success in Africa.

Total Distribution to-date of \$83,988 covers the first three quarters of Missions funded by First United Methodist Church.
