Lay and Clergy delegates from 955 United Methodist Churches across the State of South Carolina met for the first time in person since 2019 at the 2023 South Carolina Annual

Conference on June 4-7, 2023 in Florence, SC. Following is a short synopsis of the business shared:

- 12 ministers ordained as full elders, 1 minister transferred to the UMC from another denomination
- 1 person ordained as a full deacon, 5 people commissioned as provisional elders
- About 30 local pastors licensed, including Rev. Jim Creel, who officially starts part time at FUMC on July 1st
- 37 ministers retired
- A memorial service to remember the ministers who passed away since last year's annual conference
- 113 churches across the state disaffiliated, including 5 of the largest SC churches
- 2 churches closed
- Annual conference made resolutions concerning the death penalty and gun violence—read more about these resolutions at www.umcsc.org
- The Council on Finance and Administration presented a budget reduced by 15% over last year anticipating the reduction in apportionments from the disaffiliating churches
- 2024 Annual Conference will be held in Greenville, SC, June 9-12
- Lastly, Pastor Joel and Pastor Michelle reappointed to First Church for another year! And again, Jim Creel will officially join our staff on July 1 as a part time Local Pastor for Spiritual Formation
